

**Stitching In Snow Hill
Nassawango Outdoor Quilt Show
Quilt Entry Information**

1. The entry fee is \$20 for one quilt and includes a written judge's evaluation of the entry and two show admissions. Up to 4 additional quilts may be entered for an additional fee of \$5 each. All entered quilts will be judged and will receive a judge's evaluation.
2. A separate entry form and printed photograph must be submitted for each quilt. The photo may be a color photocopy or a photograph and will be used for identification and display placement purposes only. **Does not apply to quilts registered on-line.**
3. Entry forms must be received between March 1, 2011, and August 15, 2011.
4. Quilts must be **received** at Furnace Town between August 20 and September 1, 2011. Quilts will be available for **pick up** Sunday, September 11, from 12 noon to 4 pm and Tuesday, September 13, from 10 am to 5 pm or after 5:30 on September 10 with advance notification. For pick up at other times please call Furnace Town. Return shipping by USPS may be arranged.
5. Each quilt must be enclosed in a "ziplock/hefty/3X bag" - one quilt per bag.
6. Each quilt must have a label with the owner's name, address and phone number attached to the back.
7. All quilts will be displayed outdoors and must remain on display for the duration of the show.
8. If you choose, your quilt entry(s) may be for sale. On the Quilt Entry Form please indicate the retail price. Furnace Town will receive a 25% commission deducted from the retail price.
9. Quilt entry registration gives permission by the owner for the quilt to be photographed by the public, Furnace Town and the media without credit and/or compensation. These photographs may be used for publicity and promotional purposes for and about the Nassawango Outdoor Quilt Show and/or Furnace Town Living Heritage Museum.
10. Furnace Town/Nassawango Outdoor Quilt Show will take every precaution to safeguard the quilts during the show, but is not responsible for any loss to the goods and products brought on the Furnace Town premises. Insurance is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor. Quilt entry registration indicates acknowledgment and acceptance of this responsibility.
11. For judging purposes quilts will first be placed in a **technique** category and then in a **size** category. Each quilt is judged on its own merits according to the point system outlined below. Ribbons are awarded on the basis of points received. Some categories may have no ribbon winners, while others may have several winners. Quilts that are made by one individual and quilted by a second individual are to be entered by the maker with credit given to the quilter on the entry form.
12. Categories –
 - Technique (no cheater cloth or opportunity designs permitted)**
 - Pieced** - may contain more than one technique but must be 50% pieced
 - Appliqué** - may contain more than one technique but must be 50%
 - Other** - includes any that do not fit into the pieced or appliqué categories, such as whole cloth, crazy quilt, etc. Can include any that are a combination of techniques so that no one technique is 50%

Size

Large Bed Quilt - minimum of 280" in perimeter, and a maximum of 440"

Small Bed/Lap Quilt - maximum of 279" in perimeter

Wall Hanging - any size (must be made expressly to be hung on a wall)

Miniature Quilt - maximum of 40" in perimeter - the scale must be 1/12th of a standard size quilt

Special Judging Award Categories

Adult Beginner - entry of a first, second or third quilt made by a single individual age 18 and older

Young People - entry by individuals or groups age 17 and younger

Group - Quilt top must be made by more than one person

Best Quilt Begun in a Nassawango Outdoor Quilt Show workshop

Best In Show - best overall quilt entered

People's Choice - entry with the most votes from show attendees

Judge's Choice - personal favorite of judge(s)

Furnace Town Award - best quilt made with the 2011 Nassawango Block of the Month pattern series - Rebekah Rose

Best Hand Quilting - awarded to the quilter

Best Machine Quilting by maker of quilt

Best Long-arm Machine Quilting - awarded to the quilter
