

Puss in the Corner

Morris was my cat. He liked to sleep curled up at the foot of my bed most nights.

Finished block size is 12" x 12" or (9" x 9") or [6" x 6"]
All seam allowances are 1/4".

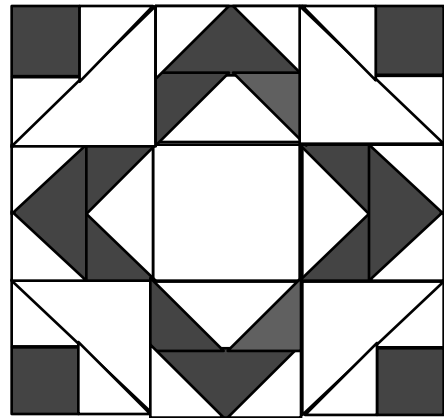
Fabric cutting:

Block background (light)

- 4 - 2½" x 4½" (2" x 3½") [1½" x 2½"] rectangles
- 2 - 5" (4") [3"] squares
- 1 - 4½" (3½") [2½"] square
- 8 - 2½" (2") [1½"] squares
- 4 - 3" (2½") [2"] squares

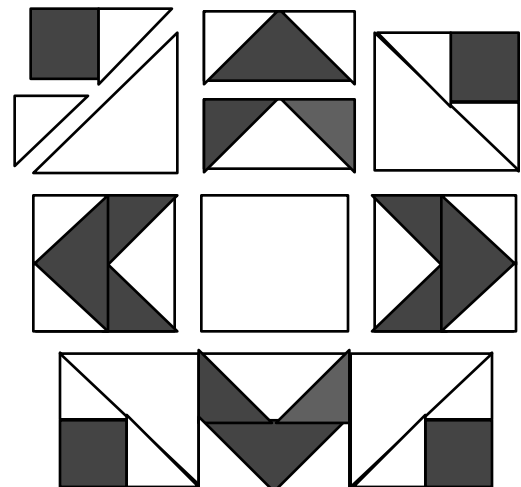
Dark

- 4 - 2½" x 4½" (2" x 3½") [1½" x 2½"] rectangles
- 12 - 2½" (2") [1½"] squares



Directions:

Flying Geese -- Referring to the "Basic Quilting" directions, make 4 (four) flying geese blocks with a light goose, and 4 (four) flying geese blocks with a dark goose. Use the rectangles and the 2½" (2") [1½"] squares.



The remaining dark 2½" (2") [1½"] squares are for the corners of the block.

Large triangles - Cut the large light 5" (4") [3"] squares on the diagonal.

Small triangles - Cut the light 4 - 3" (2½") [2"] squares on the diagonal.

Assemble block using the diagram as a reference for placement and orientation.

Finished 12" blocks may be used alone. Finished 9" or 6" block may be used alone or may be inserted into a "House" or "Star" block setting.
